1. Called to order and introduction of members by Jim Warram
2. Approval of Minutes from March Meeting – Minutes approved
3. Public Comments – No Public Comments
4. Spill Notifications – OKC had a few small spill notifications – No details given
David Barnes with OK County had a small Chlorine spill reported. No HazMat response needed.
5. Old Business –
 - 5.1. LEPC Secretary – Jon Hall has been approved as the new Secretary
 - 5.2. Annual LEPC By-Law review – By Law review was postponed until the next meeting.
6. Treasurer's Report – Report made by Dwight Dobbins.
7. New Business –
 - 7.1. Motion was introduced to support half of the cost of the Pre State Emergency Management Agency Conference (SEMAC) cookout on the 15th of August. The cost will be split with Midwest City. Motion was approved unanimously.
 - 7.2. Dwight Dobbins will have an Oklahoma County LEPC sign made for publicity purposes and plans to have it available for the SEMA Conference.
 - 7.3. Jim Warram handed out a safety flier that identified response procedures for Ethanol and Gasoline Fuel Mixtures (E-85) and how they differ from regular gasoline fires.
 - 7.4. Jami Murphy briefed on the new senate bill 1938 which will require the use of DEQ licensed contractors during remediation and cleanup activities following accidents on the Highway system within OK.

8. Program – David Barnes gave a brief on the status of the Oklahoma County Hazard Mitigation Plan and the Joint/Regional Emergency Operations Center.

8.1. Oklahoma County Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) – Oklahoma County had submitted its HMP in the past but it has not been approved as of yet. Most recent update is that it appears the Cleveland County HMP is nearing completion and is expected to be approved and to become the template for future plans. After approval the Oklahoma HMP will be re-submitted in following the Cleveland County template and David is optimistically expecting it to be approved.

8.2. Joint/Regional Emergency Operations Center – Ok. City and Ok. County are now operating a joint/Regional EOC. The EOC is located at 4600 Martin Luther King and has been made available as an alternate EOC for jurisdictions surrounding Oklahoma City. The County and City are very excited to be working together and are enjoying many improvements to their capabilities as they work together.
