1. Called to order and introduction of members by Mike Bower
2. Approval of Minutes from September Meeting – Minutes approved
3. Public Comments – No Public Comments
4. Spill Notifications – No spill notifications
5. Old Business –
 - 5.1. The State OEM had sent Mike a form to sign to receive the state grant for the LEPC, but had sent it to the post office box. Dwight picked it up and has passed it along to Mike and Mike will sign it and drop it off at OEM. We will receive a state grant in the amount of \$1000 for the submission Mike put together for the LEPC.
 - 5.2. Reviewed the status of the new Contractor Licensing requirements for material cleanup. Jim had received comments from Monte at ODEQ and forwarded them to Mike. A brief discussion reviewing the status of possible emergency rules followed and many expressed their concerns regarding the law and rules.
 - 5.3. Jami has not had the shelter-in-place handouts printed yet due to the high quote received by Kinkos. Ron Micue suggested we try Quick Print across from Integris Health, and mention their name, as they seem to get very good prices on their print jobs.

 - 7.1. The LEPC established a nominating committee for the LEPC Officer elections to be held in December. The following volunteered to sit on the committee: Jami Murphey, Jim Warram & Richard Smith.
 - 7.2. Mike Bower mentioned some training opportunities have been sent to him regarding some OEM classes. He will forward the information to Jon Hall for distribution to the LEPC members.
 - 7.3. Mike Bower briefed that there will be some Homeland Security Exercises to happen next year in Oklahoma. He will be attending a meeting tomorrow where he should learn more about them.
 - 7.4. Lloyd Smith informed the members of the LEPC that he would be conducting a continuity of business and government class next week and that the enrollment was still open for anyone who wanted to attend.
8. Program – Mike talked briefly about the exercise various LEPC members had attended October 11th. The exercise was a tabletop design that involved a large tractor-trailer involved in an accident near Lake Stanely Draper. During the accident the truck ran through an above ground pipeline valve on a pipeline carrying Diesel Fuel, allowing a large quantity of product to flow into the environment, including the lake.
