1. Called to order by Ronnie Warren.
2. February meeting minutes were approved.
3. Spill Notifications – Natural Gas pipeline cut near Memorial Road and Lake Hefner Parkway reported by Brian Stanaland. ONG shut down pipeline quickly, small amount of product escaped.
4. Public Comments – None
5. Old Business –
  - 5.1. The committee approved a request made by SMSgt Paul Ray of the Ok. Air National Guard to make a presentation about Military Support to Civil Authorities. Jon Hall will contact SMSgt Ray to determine when he would like to conduct this program.
  - 5.2. Future LEPC meeting program topics were discussed. Ronnie suggested Joe White from BNSF Railway would be an excellent speaker and also a possible Continuity of Operations (COOP) program from a POC with the US Marshals office. All members were encouraged to provide suggestions to Ronnie for other program ideas.
  - 5.3. The concept of adding attendees to the LEPC monthly Meeting Minutes was discussed. It was determined by the committee that for the next 2 months the meeting minutes will include only a list of members who have attended. After which, a list of required LEPC attendees will be added to the meeting minutes and attendance will be annotated on the meeting minutes.

Jami Murphy will provide Jon with a list of required attendees to include on the meeting minutes.
6. Treasurer's Report – Ronnie reviewed the treasurer's report.
7. New Business –
  - 7.1. Lucien Jones briefed the committee on a possible upcoming exercise between BNSF Railway and OKC Fire focusing on Interoperable Communications.

- 7.2. Ronnie introduced Bruce Jones from Midland Radio visiting from Kansas City and discussed the upcoming All Hazard Radio promotion to be held at local Super Wal-Marts again this year on April 5<sup>th</sup>. This years event will be much more robust with a significant increase in available radios. Volunteers are still needed to assist with the program. Contact Ronnie Warren to volunteer.
- 7.3. It was briefed that starting in 2009 Cox Cable will no longer offer the cable override program during severe weather events due to the switch to Digital programming by most consumers. The County EAS system will still operate as in the past.
- 7.4. Ronnie wanted to remind everyone that the Weather Sirens are an outdoor warning system and that it is only a bonus if you can hear it from inside a building or home. The public is still somewhat challenged with this concept and we should be able to explain this when questioned.
8. Program – Aubrey Campbell – DOT Hazardous Materials (short title) division. Aubrey provided a 2008 ERG update identifying changes to the upcoming ERG and a possible release date of April – June of 2008. Aubrey reminded the group that requests for ERG must be made through the state coordinator who is Dale Magnin, OK State Emergency Management. Aubrey also provided updates on upcoming regulatory changes and additions. Aubrey asked the committee to help the program by reviewing and commenting on products being provided by his department. Aubrey also identified upcoming free workshops and training seminars and asked the committee to assist in scheduling a seminar or workshop in the OKC area for 2009.
