Climate change information, planning efforts including underserved populations vulnerability impact statements that include climate change (i.e. flooding increase or decrease as the result of climate change) are a few that will impact the OK CO plan. There is funding available for jurisdictions that have high-hazard dams in their communities. OKC is the only jurisdiction that the dam grant funding would be applicable. G. Whitworth discussed the additional wording that communities will need to include to meet the new requirements.
